DOMESTIC ABUSE SCREENING GUIDE FOR CHILD SUPPORT OFFICERS

Instructions

This screening guide is designed to help you identify domestic abuse and coercive controlling behaviors in child support cases. It is a simple screen that attempts to detect whether domestic abuse is or may be an issue in the case.

You should systematically screen every adult who has applied for public assistance and assigned the right to collect child support to Human Services.

Before you begin, you should explain to the person you are working with:

- (1) What your specific role and function is in relation to the case, including:
 - That it is your job to get an order requiring the other parent to pay child support;
 - That people who receive public assistance are normally required to assign the right to go after child support to the County;
 - That a person receiving public assistance can ask for a “good cause” exemption to keep the County from seeking child support if there is a risk that the other parent might harm them or their children as a result of being ordered to pay child support;
 - Because if this, it is also your job to ask questions to find out if there are any safety concerns and, if so, to tell the public assistance recipient how to ask for a “good cause” exemption;
 - That the County must also keep your address and phone number confidential, if you ask them to for safety reasons.

- (2) The scope and/or limits of confidentiality and your duty to report suspected child abuse and certain serious crimes.

If a person discloses domestic abuse, you should:

- (1) Explain how to request a “good cause” exemption, if the person wants one;

- (2) Determine whether the person wants their address and phone number to remain confidential and, if so, take steps to make sure that it is not disclosed to the adverse party, the court, or anyone else.

- (3) Refer the person to a qualified domestic abuse advocate for safety planning assistance.
