Self Assessment

- Focus on compliance with federally established timelines and processes
- No financial penalties immediately associated with failure to meet standards
- Connections between Self-Assessment and Federal Performance

Federal Performance Measures

- Paternity Establishment
- Order Establishment
- Current Support Collections
- Arrears Collections
- Cost-Effectiveness Ratio

- Medical Support (future measure)

Federal Performance

- Focus on outcomes in federally determined areas
- Financial penalties for
 - Failure to meet minimum requirements
 - Failure to increase performance in specified increments
 - Failure to pass a data reliability audit
- Collection Base also contributes to funding calculations

How Your Work Affects CSE
